The Teen Film Project is an ongoing project that will last throughout the summer, ending with the Children's Film Festival. In June "Field Production" classes are offered, this is where they will learn the basics about running a camera and composition. The depending on interest we set up more workshops. They are different each year depending on the participants interests. Drexel H. Foundation teach the kids all they need to know on a basic skills level, for them to be creating, filing, editing, and producing. These classes will continue throughout the summer, and it will hopefully, ultimately end with the kids submitting films they have created and entering them in our Annual Film Festival & Film-markers competition. We have consumer quality cameras, a computer, software, a mic/ boom mic. stand, lighting & sound equipment, and green screens. We have a system for those involved in the project to check out equipment to create their own movies once they have taken a few classes. Our ultimate goal is to have a complete editing suite and submitted films in the festival from each of the participants.
